5. **Build a Diverse Skill Set:** Learn a wide range of skills and knowledge that can be applied in different contexts. Cross-training in various areas can make you more adaptable in both your personal and professional life.
6. **Improve Problem-Solving Skills:** Develop your problem-solving abilities by breaking down complex issues into manageable parts, brainstorming solutions, and being open to feedback and collaboration. Use a Plus/Delta chart to evaluate ideas or actions, identifying all the positive things AND all the potential issues that could result.

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7. **Enhance Emotional Intelligence:** Understand and manage your emotional triggers. Also, develop empathy and the ability to navigate interpersonal relationships, as these skills are crucial when adapting to different social situations.
8. **Embrace Change:** Instead of resisting change, accept it as a natural part of your skin school experience. Embracing change can reduce any anxiety you have and make transitions smoother.
9. **Stay Informed—and See Everything as Information:** Stay up-to-date with current events, trends, and emerging technologies. Be aware of anything that contributes to your understanding – it is neither good nor bad – see it as information! Being informed helps you anticipate changes and adapt more quickly.
10. **Network and Connect:** Build a diverse network of people from different backgrounds. Networking can provide you with valuable insights, support, and opportunities to adapt to new situations.
11. **Practice Flexibility:** Be willing to adjust your plans and strategies when necessary. Flexibility and a positive attitude are keys to adapting to unexpected circumstances.
12. **Learn from Experience:** Reflect on past experiences, both positive and negative, to internalize valuable lessons. Use these lessons to inform your decisions and actions in the future.



13. **Set Realistic Goals/Expectations. Know What You CAN Control versus What You Can Influence:** Set achievable and flexible goals. Be realistic in your expectations. This allows you to adapt your plans as circumstances change while still working toward what you want to achieve.
14. **Seek Feedback:** Solicit feedback from trusted colleagues, mentors, and friends. Constructive feedback helps you identify areas for improvement and take the steps necessary for your success.

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15. **Take Care of Your Well-being:** Ensure you maintain good physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual health. Your overall health will equip you to handle change and adapt effectively.
16. **Bring your poise to the noise:** Challenge yourself to step out of your comfort zone if it's necessary. Trust in your spiritual guidance, and remember – present moments are your time zone!
17. **Develop a Gratitude Mindset.** Look for Gratitude opportunities; maintain a Gratitude Journal; spread words of Gratitude; and become aware of how Gratitude feels within your beingness.
18. **Put Your 13 Powers and 7 Core Abilities into action at the “Sweet Spot” level.** Remember your Powers and Core Abilities are always at work, so intentionally call on them to build resilience, flexibility, and adaptability.
19. **Meditate in a Variety of Ways.** Remember, Meditation is a category (just like Music, Food, or Sports are categories, each with a huge variety of possibilities branching out from the category. Dip your toe into a variety of meditation techniques, and grow from the exposure!
20. **Be Kind to Yourself and Give Yourself Time to Adapt.** Selfcare is a key to being in the right mindset and physical shape to adapt to changes or rebound to setbacks. When you feel that inner resistance, take a step away, do something nice for yourself, and claim a “Time Out” before reacting to the situation.
